### **Treasurer's Report**

- In the future, Mrs. Raviella Green & Mrs. Hyde will collaborate on the report documents together
- Making a very good profit increase with price of pizza slice raised (\$649.80)
- Money available to spend is higher than originally expected
- Mrs. Callea-Ruiu: please confirm chips/pop is set aside for Grade 8 grad? (Mrs. Hyde will confirm)

### **Food Calendar**

- Special food day (pick the day, but do not choose the food)
- 'Fun Food Day' (can decide closer to the time, based on schedule/sales/best opportunity)
- Choose 'Fun Food Day' for calendar
- Base around grade 8 days, other events, etc.
- Friday pizza day for every week (only Friday's, when the school is open)
- 1st Friday of every month for sub day (deposit goes into account every month for pizza)
- Do 'Fun Food Day' once a month (Tuesday's on the second week)
- Mr. Ferretti & Mrs. Callea-Ruiu to decide exact Tuesday dates (6 pizza days; aiming for \$700; they will do 2 Tuesday's)
- Fun Food Dates: November 13, December 11, January 15, February 12, March \*skip, April 16, May 14, June 11

### **Mrs. Schmidt inquires as to School Incident not being on the agenda**

- Told it cannot be discussed as its not on the agenda (Condari)
- Can be discussed in January at next council meeting under Safety and Security/Emergency Preparedness
- Lockdown procedures?

- Procedure that happened?
- Brief discussion of whether it was contained and handled well (Mrs. Hyde)
- Condari shared the situation was controlled, being dealt with, and the crisis support team was involved
- Conversation on security of children during school time
- Outside security questions for while children are out on school playground
- Condari shared that teacher's outside are being more diligent now
- Safety component for future discussion
- Superintendent to plan with school? (Will there be a Town Hall Meeting?)
- Emergency preparedness to discuss in January
- Forum for parents?
- Healing the kids? Helping the students through the trauma of the incident?
- Lunch monitoring preparedness in case of emergency?
- Social worker provided for students/families as desired (Mrs. DeSantis)
- Would need to come from individual parents (to provide that type of intervention)
- Ensure schools protocols revealed & that appropriate actions of safety and security that follow under the board and the law are taking place
- Always staff around that front office (Condari, Mrs. Callea-Ruiu)
- Mrs. Peszuiti (speak to regarding further information)

### **McMillan's Christmas Planning**

- 35% profit off every dollar sold
- Banner for school display
- Educate school on how to make most use of this
- Only 2 delivery dates: all orders received by end of November; then delivered by December 5th (not enough time); all orders in by December 5; will arrive in school by December 19th
- December 19th (10am-7:30 pm) Setup alphabetical stations with food all sorted per person (one person responsible for original input, other person confirms items)
- Parents come in at pickup after school (or if small order, will ask permission to send home with the student) 1pm-7:30 pm (let parents know it's available for pickup by 1pm)
- Keep gym door open to keep it cold

- Christmas assembly will be moved to next day (December 20th)

- Had to bring money in for haunted house, pizza & raffle (next year won't be doing the raffle as it's too much)

- Media Arts program collaborates and does pictures with Santa? (Rita)

- Class photos with Santa ? (Life Touch/Mrs. Hyde)
- Didn't cost the parents anything
- Backdrop done for stage on the 19th (and Santa on the 19th?)
- Santa on the stage
- Meet the Teacher night (coffee/treats; and have MacMillan's available to pre-sell; also get to know the council)
- Raffle (Mrs. Green can get gift certificates and items for Meet the Teacher at discount)
- Class photos with Santa from Life Touch or Media Arts program (19th), no raffle or other school gathering
- Send letter home by Monday (Mrs. Hyde to send letter for approval on the weekend)

### **Boogiethon Update**

- Phone call reminder (created urgency/confusion, yet November 16th is due date)
- Received feedback from the community
- 4 major events: Haunted House (3-4; loved the jump scares, characters, props; next year would like a change up when they go around a second time, and more dark), Mall Area (4) loved the music, loved the space, being with classmates, Gymnasium (2+ 3-) grade 7s organized the games and had to get the students to rotate; want games gone and Gymnasium into a night club and Haunted House on stage, mall area: 1 game if tired dancing, Candy Raffle (1) because parents spending too much already and not wanting extra candy, Rest station (movies, popcorn)
- Admission fee for the dance (grade 7 & 8s run everything) \*aren't receiving pledges for grades 7 and 8 (only \$2-\$5) charge \$2 Haunted House, \$5 Dance (goal of \$15 per kid)
- Only allowed 1 dance per year, and that's for graduation
- Future idea: have Halloween pictures (photo booth as revenue source), characters from Haunted House

### **CYO**

- Schools have to pay \$500 for levy every year (subsidize/offset partnership with Athletics)
- Funds can also be used from donations with school council
- Helps send kids to Marydale programs, etc.

### **Growing Success/Progress Reports**

- Grades 1 - 8: this will be a snapshot, not as detailed as February or June reports
- (Eg. Progressing Well, Generally Well, etc.)
- Math, Language, and anywhere progressing with difficulty

- As for teacher to elaborate on any specific area, what can they do to progress/receive higher achievements in the future?
