The International Languages Program (Elementary) is offered by St. Charles Adult & Continuing Education, a school of the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board.

The focus of the Elementary Program is to offer children an opportunity to develop and/or maintain the ability to listen, speak and write a new language or the language of the home or heritage. The program is offered in addition to the regular school curriculum and enrolment is voluntary.

### Eligibility

Any child that is 4 years old as of December 31st, of a new school year, enrolled in an elementary school, home-schooled, or private school in Ontario is eligible to participate. Previous knowledge of the language is not required. Children may learn a language that is not of their heritage.

### Registration

Registration takes place on, or before the first day of the program. However, this is a continuous entry program and students are accepted throughout the month of July.

The form requires your child's Ontario Education Number, (OEN) which can be found on your child's report card.

Children entering Year 1 Kindergarten must show proof of age.

Classes will only run if there is sufficient enrolment.

### Cost

There is no registration fee.



### Courses

Armenian, Azerbaijani, Cantonese, Hungarian, Italian, Japanese, Lithuanian, Malayalam, Mandarin, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Slovenian, Spanish, Urdu, Vietnamese.

### Requirements

Internet connection and a device complete with a keyboard.

### Duration of Program

Classes are held once a week for 2.5 hours per day. September 18, 2021 - June 11, 2022
