7	<p><u>Principal's Update:</u></p> <p>A. Recess Action Plan School Teams (L.E.A.D. Recess)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Grade 8s were trained by Lynn Campanella from Playocracy with creating recess games and conflict resolution for the primary students. - Student champions were chosen to teach and run organized games during recess for the primary classes. - Student L.E.A.D.ers are creating a Kateri Playbook which will have rules specific to SKT for the common games played along with the newly created games; as well as, general expectations for play. This will be their legacy. The purpose is to have a common understanding of the rules to decrease conflict/arguments.
